Winterizing tips:

Disconnect and drain garden hoses.

Clean chimney to remove soot and creosote.

If needed, install or

replace weather-stripping around doors and windows.

Inspect roof, gutters and downspouts for potential problems.

If you leave your home for extended periods of

time, leave the heat set at 55 to prevent pipes from freezing.

Prepare an emergency kit incase of a power outages due to winter storms.
