While we have made many upgrades to our trail system over the last several months, we do work

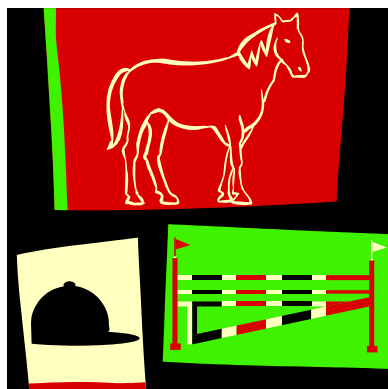


on a budget. If the work you perform is unauthorized, and creates a negative impact on the trail, you will be responsible for paying to have it returned to its proper condition.
