New Business: The Annual Meeting is scheduled for the 28th immediately before the Potluck. Three Director positions need to be filled. Candidates are Sillman,

Brian Matchette, Tracey Hatcher and Ned Helm. Candidates will be voted on at the Annual Meeting prior to the Potluck.

The problem with regard to the Commercial Operators using SCTA trails was presented by Presented Vaughn. The Commercial Operators are using our trails and are not paying anything toward trail maintenance. It was decided that President Vaughn draft a letter to the Commercial Operators that they pay /\$250.00 per year or the equivalent amount of materials. Passed.

Brian Matchette was appointed to serve as Trail Coordinator replacing Tom Pickard who resigned.

A motion was made that all expenditures in excess of \$500.00 be approved by the Board. Passed

Trail Work Day: Motion was made to hold SCTA trail Work Days for the weekend after July 4th and the weekend after Labor Day (September 12th.) Passed

Motion made to pay VEC and the water company. Suggested amount: VEC \$300 and the water company \$200.00. Passed

Motion to winterize the Pavilion instead of heating the bathrooms to cut costs. Passed.
