| 1        | 11-2011 | <b>Re OPENDED From 2013</b>           | TEE PEE Loop trail down to the creek is washed out on both sides/probably needs cross ties/step down and some re-routing to improve drainage and footing Ricky Rains owns the property.   | Moved trail to a new location on April 18 <sup>th</sup> 2013, but it has washed out and is very muddy. May have to move back to the original location.   | <i>6-2013 Ricky said to do whatever it takes to fix the mud problem.<br/>Nov. 2013 Brenda/Joe led effort to provide a temp. improvement.<br/><br/>Had 4 work days to lay fabric and 5 loads of rock. <b>Need to assess in spring 2015.</b></i>  |
| 2        | 09-2010 | <b>OPEN Moved from 2010/2011 List</b> | Wildcat Den trail-severe drop off in several places is washing out again, plus area down to the creek is washed out/alternate path has roots sticking out. Should probably remove tree stump down by the creek area.<br>Note: The trail goes across a 2,000 acre tract of land owned by the Sloan family which is not part of Spruce Creek. | Sharon and Dino (works for Danny) installed 4 cross tie step downs at the first big drop off which did help. Sharon, Ricky, Bev, Pete, and Laurie walked it again 11-22-10 as part of Board meeting.<br><b>JUNE 2011</b><br>Roger and Lee did some work to clear around stump<br><b>May 2013</b><br>Stump has been removed | <i>Wallace Linder (the care taker for the Sloans (owners) said they will allow us to re route the trail/build some switch backs!!!! YEAH!!!!<br/>Danny and Wally have marked the new trail with ribbons.<br/>Laurie and Tracey working with lawyer (Jim Roamer) obtained legal document requested by Sloan family.<br/>June 2014....new route cut on our side of the creek...much improved.<br/>March 2015....new route cut on far side.<br/>Still need rock and creek crossing work.</i> |
