Estimate: \$500 to recut run offs (complete-paid \$250) \$1,000-\$2,000 to cross creek and place RR ties, paper and rock | | Re-route completed in March 2015. Foundation paper and rock on our side of creek put down in Oct. 2015 and April 2016 4-2016 Wally said we do NOT need to put interlocking pavers across the creek! And....we perhaps could access/drop rock by "Waynes" on Hicks Ridge. 2016 Needs foundation paper, 3 or 4 RR tires and rock on the other side of the creek. 2017 Could also use some rock on our side of the creek |

Estimate: \$1,500-\$1,800 | <i>Perhaps a drainpipe or culvert would help.</i> <i>Note: this is NOT Keith Holly’s land</i> | 4-2016 Danny put down 3 loads of rock and grated. Needs to “settle” 5-2016 Recent rains undid much good work 2017 needs RR ties, rock and grating |
| 4 | 06-2010 | OPEN Moved from 2010/2011 List | Evergreen Trail – from 297 side has giant ravine, washout, cross ties moved- and need to be replaced. Also needs rock. Estimate: \$2,000 - \$2,500 | | <i>In 2012, Owner-Scott Kwierant (and Kathy – Vets) said he would probably allow us to reroute some on his land, in discussing with Tracey, but could affect run off on Shelton DeWits property.</i> <i>Danny put down 2 loads of rock on July 3 2012 which provided improvement.</i> <i>4-2016 Danny laid down rock and grated needs to settle</i> <i>6-2016 Daniel who works for Danny did the chain saw work – 8 trees</i> |

| 6 | 04-2012 | OPEN Moved from 2013 list | A deep wet spring continues to reappear and erode the trail beside Jaimie W. property. March 2015 We closed trail. <i>3-2016. Reopen to Crocket Crest ... need to move the trail closed sign.</i> | <i>Even a bridge could be a problem as the wet springs and sink holes appear/reappear</i> | <i>2014 and 2015 Matt Stringfield let us re-route the trail onto his property....put it up on the bank... redone several times. Still a problem. Perhaps a slabwood road-see Dave Duchon. 2016 Perhaps re-route completely to come out on Wilderness Trail?</i> |
