TPE 2	Tee Pee 2	Tee Pee Loop from the Spruce Cr Trail intersection to Proctor Ridge Trail
TPE 3	Tee Pee 3	Tee Pee Loop from the Proctor Ridge Trail, along Spruce Cr Dr to intersection with Wild Cat Den Trail
TPE 4	Tee Pee 4	Tee Pee Loop from Wild Cat Den Trail intersection to the Pavilion
TPE 5	Tee Pee 5	Part of Tee Pee Loop that runs up behind Crockett Creek Dr.
PRR	Proctor Ridge	from Intersection of Tee Pee Loop to BSF boundary
WLC 1	Wild Cat 1	Wild Cat Den Trail from Spruce Creek Road to Wild Cat Den Road
WLC 2	Wild Cat 2	Wild Cat den Trail from Wild Cat Den Road to Hatfield Creek
WLC 3	Wild Cat 3	Wild Cat Den Trail from Hatfield Creek to BSF Boundary (to Saw Tooth overlook)

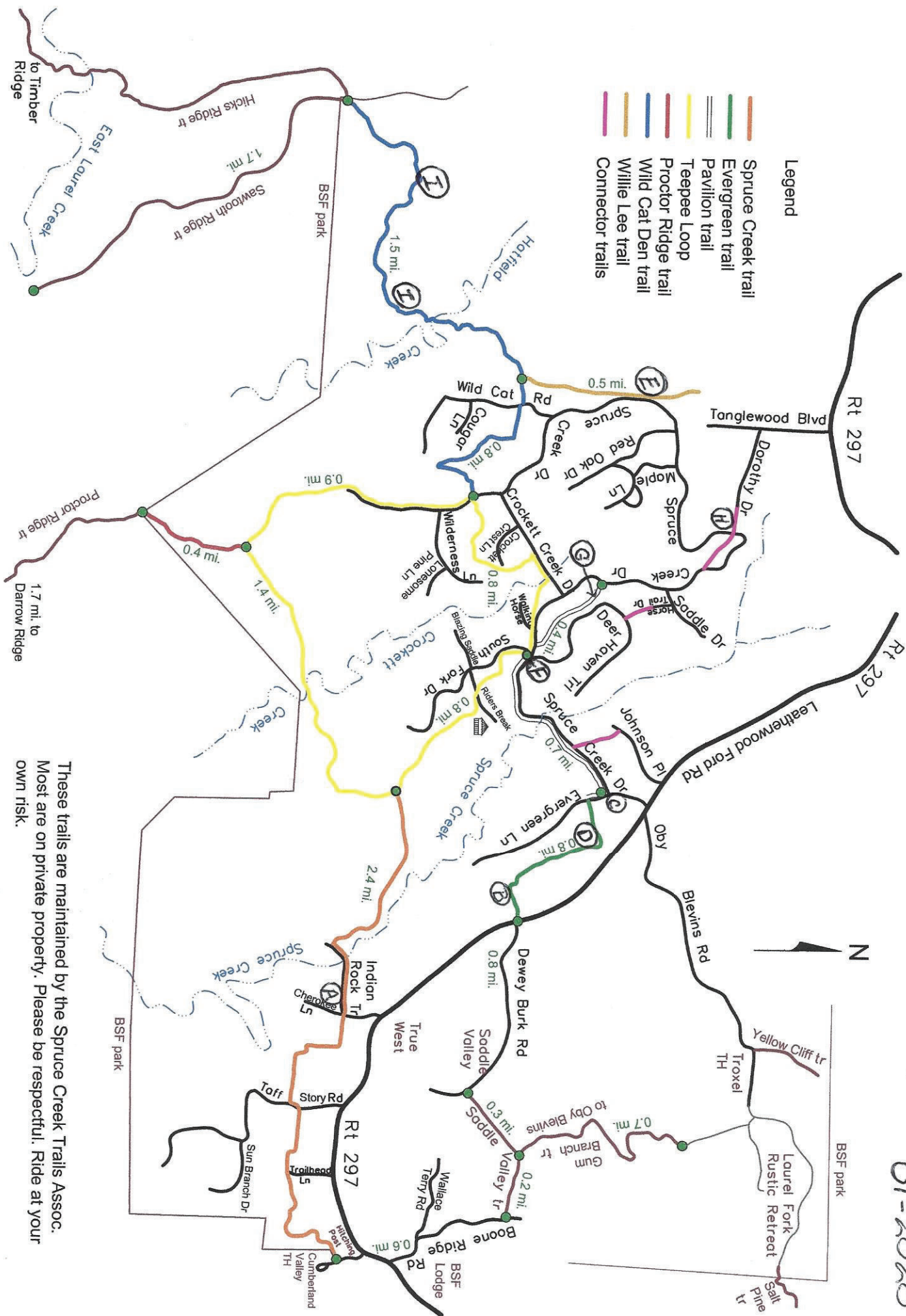
